## DRIVING DIRECTIONS

**Northbound I-5 – Take Exit 254.** East on Iowa St 1 mile. Left on Woburn St  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile. Right on Alabama St, 2 miles to lake. Turn right  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile. Entrance to Park on left.

**Southbound I-5 – Take Exit 255.** East on Mt. Baker Highway 1 mile. Right on Woburn St 1 mile. Left on Alabama St, 2 miles to Lake. Turn right  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile. Entrance to Park on left.
