DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From the North: Highway 167 becomes Highway 512. Take 512 to the top of the hill, south of the Fairgrounds. Exit right on 94th Avenue, proceed to 9th Avenue SW. Turn left onto Perimeter Road, pass Sears and Competitive Edge Fitness on the right. The road bears right at the brick wall. Continue to the right to the parking area behind the Theatre. Enter through doors that lead into the mall. You should see Penney's across the aisle way. Tables start at the junction of the aisle ways and to the left.

From the South: Exit I-5 to Highway 512. Continue on 512, for about 8 miles and take the WA-161 Exit toward South Hill/Eatonville/Mt Rainier. Turn left onto 31st Avenue SW. Continue to the mall entrance. Turn left at Toys-R-Us. At the T intersection, turn left (on the perimeter Road around Mall) passing Sears and Competitive Edge Fitness on the right. When the road bears to the right continue to the right to the parking area at the mall entrance. Enter through doors that lead into the mall. You should see Penney's across the aisleway. Tables start at the junction of aisle ways and to the left.

GALLOP TO PUYALLUP ~ 2001Class 305
Incorporate anything connected with a horse using at least one dahlia originated in 2001.

MOO THE PUYALLUP ~ 1998Class 306
Incorporate anything connected with a cow using at least one dahlia originated in 1998.
