DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Southbound I-5 – Take Exit 255. East on Mt. Baker Highway 1 mile. Right on Woburn St 1 mile. Left on Alabama St, 2 miles to Lake. Turn right $\frac{1}{4}$ mile. Entrance to Park on left.
