Driving Directions:

- Travel two miles to Route 1. From right lane, take Hwy 1 west to Vancouver.
- Travel three miles to the Clearbrook Exit 87. At Clearbrook Rd., turn north for one mile to Garden Park Tower, located on the left (highrise).
- This is a total of six miles from the border.

- Dahlias must dominate, although other flowers may be used.
