In lieu of a judged dahlia show, the North Central Washington Dahlia Society will be sponsoring a dahlia exhibition in 2021. Although the bulk of this exhibition will not be judged, we invite growers of all abilities to exhibit dahlias in all the main horticultural and other special classes. Cash prizes will be awarded by random drawing from tickets given to exhibitors for every entry they bring to the show. Everyone will have a chance to win! There will be a limited number of judged sections as outlined below.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Coming into town from the North on US-2:

- US-2 becomes WA-285. This is Wenatchee Avenue. Continue south until you get to Fifth Street. Get in the left turn lane.
- Turn left onto Fifth Street, go under the train tracks and into the traffic circle. Stay right in the traffic circle and follow it south onto Riverside Drive. Stay on Riverside Drive until you get to the stop sign at Worthen Street.
- Turn left onto Worthen and follow it for about 7 blocks. You will see the Pybus Public Market on the east side of the street, at the foot of Worthen and Orondo Avenue.

Coming from the South on WA-28:

- Follow highway signs for Wenatchee, crossing the George Sellar Bridge. Take the off-ramp on the right, to Wenatchee Avenue (SR 285 N.)
- Head north on Wenatchee Avenue for about a mile. When you get to Orondo Street, turn right and go across the railroad tracks. You will see the Pybus Market parking lot directly in front of you.

To Unload: Bring dahlias through the doors on the south end of the building. If you have questions, there will be people to help you find your way around. The show will take place in the center concourse of the Market. There will be a designated staging area, outside the Market building. Supplies will be limited with a small number of display vases and show cans. We will have a number of first-time exhibitors and want to ensure that they are able to learn to stage their entries. Please bring your own staging foam or pre-stage your entries with your own supplies as much as possible.

In addition to the horticultural sections, the special sections below will also offer tickets for each entry and winners will be drawn at the Saturday night dinner.

HYBRIDIZERS AND COMMERCIAL GROWERS Class 270

Be creative! Exhibit single entries, triple collections or 5-bloom collections of your originations or dahlia varieties that your business represents. We will provide your business information to visitors to the show on a flyer at our Information Table.

FIRST TIME EXHIBITORS Class 271

This section is for people who have never entered a dahlia show before. We will be accepting single bloom entries of dahlias that you have grown in your garden. We will have a staging table near the south entrance of Pybus where you will find help for staging your flowers for show.

FLOATING WATERLILY DAHLIA Class 272

Single waterlily boom, floating in a bowl that is wider than it is tall, in clear water with no greenery.

VASE OF DAHLIAS Class 273

Brighten up our Market by creating a colorful vase of dahlias and other greens and vegetation from your garden! Two winner of a \$25 each prize will be selected through a random drawing, with exhibitors receiving one entry ticket for each vase entered. These bouquets and vases will be offered for sale to the public, following the close of the show on Sunday. Your donated vase is welcome, or we can provide a vase.

ARRANGEMENTS

TOGETHER AGAIN - GETTING BACK TO NORMAL Class 274

Be creative - what does this mean to you and your community. Dahlias must predominate.

PEOPLE'S CHOICE Class 275

A ticket will not be awarded for this class. The public will vote and the winner will receive the people's choice cash award. Only one entry per person and only the *first* entry of any variety is eligible. Public only is eligible to vote: no exhibitor voting, please.

OPEN HOUSE AT THE CHELAN BUTTE DAHLIARY

Lindsay and Scott Williams have opened the newest commercial dahlia farm in Washington state. They will host a farm open house & tour after judging has been completed on Saturday.

Located at MP 4.1 – Stayman Flats Road in Chelan – this working farm has been coaxed out of the north central Washington shrub-steppe near the Columbia River and Lake Chelan.

HOW TO GET TO CHELAN BUTTE DAHLIARY

Directions:

- Take Hwy 97-A from Wenatchee, through Entiat, and then about 8 more miles to the turnoff at Stayman Flats Rd (LAST turn, on the right, before the tunnel)
- then 4.2 miles down Stayman Flats Rd. (If you start going up the big hill, they have missed the turnoff.)
- The house address across the street is 420.

Parking will be just past that house on the right, but the farm is on the left. It is about 35 minutes & 29 miles from the Wenatchee 97-A turnoff to the farm.
