DRIVING DIRECTIONS

- From the right lane, take Hwy 1 west to Vancouver.
- Travel three miles to the Clearbrook Exit 87.
- At Clearbrook Rd., turn north for one mile to Garden Park Tower, located on the left.

This is a total of six miles from the border.

Arrangement rules: Maximum size of entry - 24 inches square. No artificial plant material allowed. No mechanical devices are allowed that require plug ins. Plant material need not be grown by the exhibitor, but all exhibits must be arranged by the exhibitor. Dahlias must dominate, although other flowers may be used.
