- After passing Cloverdale stay in the left lane as Pine splits right and West President Drive left.
- Turn left on President Drive. The venue will be on your left.

CELEBRATE IDAHO

SAWTOOTH NATIONAL RECREATION AREA..... Class 301

The Sawtooth Range is a mountain range of the Rocky Mountains. It has 40 peaks rising over 10,000 feet and 300 plus alpine lakes. Create an arrangement inspired by this spectacular mountain scenery in any season.

BRUNEAU DUNES..... Class 302

Bruneau Dunes State Park is home to the tallest free-standing sand dunes in North America. Create an arrangement inspired by this sandy oasis.

SHOSHONE FALLS PARK..... Class 303

The Niagara of the West, Shoshone Falls is most spectacular in the spring from the snow runoff. Create an arrangement inspired by the water movement.

Dahlias must dominate in all arrangements, which must fit within a 24” x 24” square space.
