VASE OF DAHLIAS Class 265

Vase of exhibitor's choice, containing 12 dahlias, with or without greenery, color variation allowed, type of dahlias may vary. Will be judged as a vase suitable for informal all-around home display. Note: Definition of a Vase: A container taller than its width.

FLOATING WATERLILY Class 266

A single waterlily, floating in a bowl that is wider than it is tall, in clear water, no greenery or pin frogs allowed.

PEOPLE'S CHOICE..... Class 267

Single Entry. Each exhibitor may enter only one entry in people's choice. Winner will be selected by popular vote of the public. Ballots close at 3:00 pm on Sunday.

FIRST-TIME EXHIBITOR..... Class 268

Single-bloom entry, any size. Staged in one container.

All entries in this section must be made by the exhibitor in his or her own container. Some dahlias must be used in all classes. Dahlias need not be grown by the exhibitor. Only one entry per person per class is allowed. A width of 24 inches is allotted for each exhibit except in class 308. An exhibit is composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories. Fresh-cut, dried, weathered, or treated plant material, or any combination may be used.
