CLASS 62 - ARRANGEMENT THEME
THE WORLD IS A FAIR
Emphasis on Japan

- Lot#
- 1 **The Fair Theme** “The World is a Fair”
At least 3 small dahlias and a small accessory (Accessory is optional)
 - 2 **Ikabana Style Vertical Arrangement** with bright colored small dahlias and branched with small colored flowers. (Not Baby’s Breath). *Sticks or stick cheery colors and greenery.*
 - 3 **Japan:** *A dahlia arrangement that identifies with Japan. No more than 24” border - greenery*
 - 4 **Pick a country** *you would like to have your dahlia arrangement represent.*
 - 5 **Riverfront Park:** *Dahlia arrangement highlighting something left in Riverfront Park from the 1974 World’s Fair.*
 - 6 **Designers choice** – *More than one Dahlia*
 - 7 **Japanese Rock Garden:** *Use the 4 elements of a Japanese garden: rocks, water, plants ornament and greenery.*

CLASS 63 - BOUQUETS—White Tags Only

- 1 Old-Fashioned bouquet of **dahlias only**.

 - 5 - Mini Basket—Under 12” and at least 5 blooms (Judged Separately)
