STAGING:

REMOVAL OF ENTRIES:

Exhibitors are required to leave entries on the tables until show closing at 5:00 pm. Those entrants who cannot remove their entries are expected to make arrangements for someone to do so for them.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From the North: Take Hwy 99 south to the 16th Ave. exit (Exit # 4). Go east on 16th Avenue to 172nd and turn Right. The garden is 1 block south of the intersection

From the South: The garden is 5 minutes north of the Pacific Hwy Truck Crossing. Take the Pacific Hwy truck crossing, travel North on Hwy 15 (176th St), turn Left on 16th Ave and turn Left on 172nd. The garden is one block south of the intersection.

The greenhouse can be entered from the main entrance. Please move your vehicle away from the main entrance once unloaded.
