DRIVING DIRECTIONS

South Hill Mall, 3500 South Meridian, Puyallup

From the North: Highway 167 becomes Highway 512. Take 512 to the top of the hill, south of the Fairgrounds. Exit right on 94th Avenue, proceed to 9th Avenue SW. Turn left onto Perimeter Road, past Target on the right. The road bears right at the brick wall. Continue to the right to the parking area behind Regal Cinemas. Enter through doors that lead into the mall at Victoria’s Secret. You should see Penney’s across the aisleway. WSDS tables go from center court and continue down the aisleway, just past where you entered the mall.

From the South: Exit I-5 to Highway 512. Continue on 512, for about 8 miles, take the 9th St SW/94th Ave E. Exit. Continue straight through the traffic light, turn left at the Mall sign, passing Gold Fish Swim School and Round 1 Bowling and Arcade on the right, When the road bears to the right continue to the right to the parking area at the Mall entrance at Victoria’s Secret. Enter through doors that lead into the mall. You should see Penney’s across the aisleway. WSDS tables go from center court and continue down the aisleway, just past where you entered the mall.

to the Puyallup people. Use red, orange, and/or bronze dahlias and incorporate wood in your design.*

POINT DEFIANCE PARK..... Class 306

*A scenic park offering more than 700 acres of woodland trails, gardens and waterfront views along with a zoo
and aquarium. Use a variety of dahlias and incorporate water in your design.*
